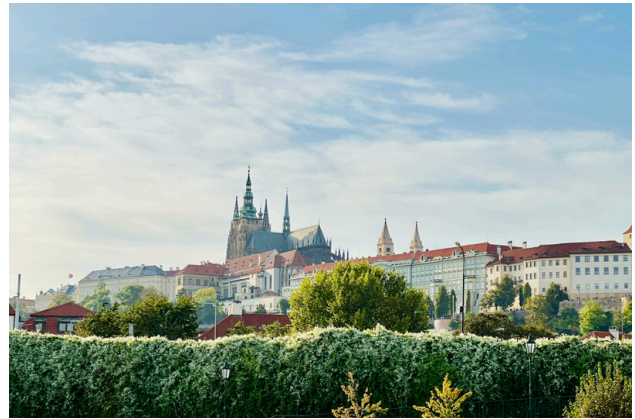

3rd day: Carlsbad & Museum with Moser Glassworks (130 km west of Prague)

Karlovy Vary (Carlsbad) is one of Europe's most beautiful spas. It excels especially by its unique architecture, imposing colonnades, exclusive spa buildings and a wonderful layout in the heart of a forested valley.

Nowadays Karlovy Vary hosts many movie stars thanks to its film festival, which is one of Europe's most important. Tasting of Mineral springs, Moser Glassworks and Moser Museum Visit - we will see spa promenade, the largest thermal spring water in Karlovy Vary – Vřídlo - reaching up to 12 meters and the temperature is 73.4 °C). We will go by cable car to Diana lookout, where is beautiful view of the city. Next stop will be in the Moser glassworks, where you will see the production of crystal objects. Explore the honourable history of more than 155 years old production of art crystal Moser glass and discover the mystery of its hand making (possibility of shopping). Dinner in local restaurant, overnight in hotel.



4th day: Tour of Pilsen – city of world famous “Pilsner beer”

Visit of Pilsner Urquell brewery – St. Bartholomew's Cathedral – Great Synagogue and Old Synagogue. In late afternoon transfer to Ceske Budejovice, dinner and overnight in hotel.

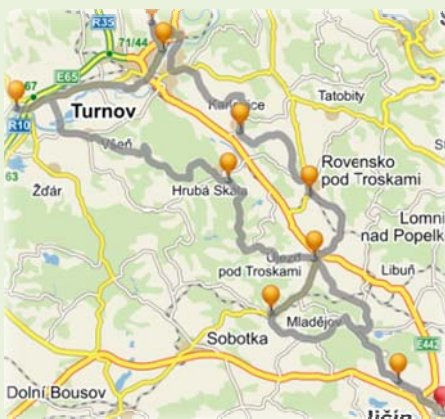

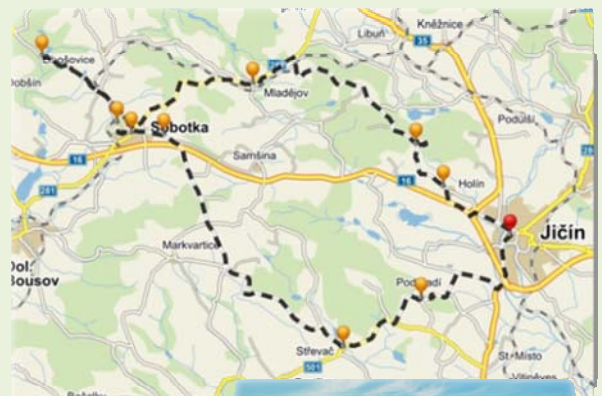

Tour with a visit of the most famous breweries in the Czech Republic, with relaxing in beer spa and with visit the beer pub. The Czech Republic is a country where beer is a national treasure. It'd be hard to find anybody in the entire country who would doubt that Czech beer is the best in the world. The tradition of hop cultivation has a long history in the Czech Republic. 1st day: Pilsen brewery – Beerspa in Tabor

In the morning transfer to the West Bohemian city of Pilsen, where we will visit the Brewery Museum, Pilsen historic underground, brewery and school of pouring beer.

Learn about the history of the legendary Pilsner Urquell lager beer and its secrets behind. It all started in 1842 and since that



time its fame has spread throughout the world, making it the inspiration for more than

two-thirds of the beer produced in the world today, which are still called pils, pilsner, and pilsener. You will see the whole brewing process, bottling plant, exposition on the ingredients and the historic and modern Pilsner Urquell brew house. In late
